This program enables our students to improve their French while discovering the art, culture, gastronomy and countryside of the French Riviera.

FULL PACKAGE PROGRAM INCLUDES :

- ✓ **Standard courses** : 20 lessons/week from Monday to Friday
- ✓ **Accommodation** : in high standard residence
- ✓ **Half board** : breakfast and lunch from Monday to Friday in the school restaurant
- ✓ **Activity program** : 4 half-day excursions or activities/week, one full day excursion during the weekend, one cultural evening/week

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- Minimum entry level: **A2**.
- The availability of **Closed and International classes** is dependant on participant numbers.
- The **activity program** offered below can be subject to changes.
- No lessons on **French national holidays**, nor on the Monday of arrival

SAMPLE OF ACTIVITIES

➤ HALF DAY EXCURSIONS:

- **Antibes**: The old town is famous for its ramparts along the sea and the long wall along the port. There are plenty of little streets to explore, a lot of restaurants to taste Provençal cuisine, and lots of shops to buy original gifts.
- **Saint Paul de Vence / The Maeght Foundation**: It is a beautiful medieval fortified village, one of the most intact medieval examples of the region, with much of the ramparts still there.

The Maeght Foundation is a true museum in nature; it is an exceptional site that contains one of the most important collections in Europe, with paintings, sculptures; drawings and graphic works from the 20th century: Bonnard, Braque, Calder, Chagall, Giacometti, Léger, Miró...

- **Grasse perfumery (Fragonard):** Different laboratories and workshops allow understanding the fabrication process involved in creating a perfume. The museum displays an exceptional and rare collection of perfume artefacts spanning 5000 years of history.
- **Cannes:** Cannes is the "star" of the French Riviera, famous for the International Film Festival and its "Palais des Festivals" which rolls the red carpet out for international stars of the silver screen every year. Luxury hotels, cars, beaches attract tourists from around the world.
- **Monaco:** With its exceptional location, between mountain and sea, Monaco is a highly cultured place with many museums, the best hotels in the world, the sumptuous gastronomy and well-known restaurants.

➤ **HALF DAY ACTIVITIES:**

- **Wine tasting in "Chateau du Bellet":** One of the oldest vineyards in France, famous all over the world for its "Bellet" wine.
- **Game of Petanque (or boules):** The sport that is closest to French hearts especially in the South of France. It is traditionally played with metallic balls on a dirt surface beneath plane trees.
- **Lesson of Provençal cuisine followed by a tasting of the cooked dish:** In the kitchen with the Chef students will find out how to cook the typical Provençal dishes like "Farcis niçois" (Provençal stuffed vegetables) or "Tarte aux pignons".

➤ **CULTURAL EVENING:**

- **Theatre:** play or show according to the theatre program.

➤ **FULL DAY EXCURSION:**

- **Nice:** Warm climate, diverse scenery, rich plant life, beautiful blue seas...it is possible to find all this in Nice, the capital of the Côte d'Azur. It is home to a large number of museums (Chagall, Matisse, Museum of Modern Art, etc.) and theatres.
