- STUDENTS:** European MPs and diplomats, EU and Council of Europe officials, officials from international institutions (EPO, ICJ, NATO, etc.), European and international lawyers etc

- ORGANISATION:** (30 lessons per week = 23 hours) 1 week to 6 weeks/4 students maximum per group

- ✓ Improve written and oral comprehension, gain confidence in oral expression and interaction in a French-speaking environment.
 - ✓ Handle professional and paraprofessional situations in French in European towns and institutions (Brussels, Strasbourg, Luxembourg, Frankfurt, Rome etc.).
 - ✓ Handle professional situations which require written and oral expression and comprehension
 - ✓ Introduction to or refresher in French and European legal, political, historical and cultural contexts
- LEVEL:** *Levels B1(intermediate) to C2 (advanced)
