



INDIVIDUAL COURSES

ORGANISATION

- Duration : 45 minutes per course.
- Number of lessons according to the student's needs.
- Monday to Friday, between 9.00am and 6.00pm.
- 1 person maximum.

EVALUATION TEST

The online evaluation test and a questionnaire must be completed before the course.

LEVEL

All levels from beginner to advanced (Common European Frame of Reference).

OBJECTIVES

- Acquisition of the fundamentals of French grammar.
- Development of practical communicative functions for speaking and writing.
- Creation of a specific tailor-made program adapted to the student's needs.

PROGRAMME

- Grammar program according to the student's level and specific request.
- Oral comprehension and expression.
- Written comprehension and expression.
- Work on the themes the student wishes to study.

METHODOLOGY

An interactive teaching method developed by the CIA and adapted to the CEFR levels:

- Simulations and role plays.
- Didactic and interactive activities.
- Promotion of the autonomy of the students according to their needs and their personal or professional objectives.

TEACHING MATERIAL

Use of a wide range of teaching materials:

- Specialized handbooks and material created by out teaching staff.
- Authentic documents as well as entirely made-up material (visual, audio, or written material).
- Documents and material for French as a foreign language.
- Intensive use of the video, the camcorder, Internet, dvd etc.
