ONE-TO-ONE ONLINE CLASSES

One-to-one course with 1 teacher or two-to-one course with 2 students (of the same level) with 1 teacher to better take into account the **specific needs** expressed by the student with an optimization of the quality of teaching.

DURATION: Minimum 2 hours (2 X 60mn) per week

TIMETABLE: To be agreed

LEVEL: Beginner to advanced

Lesson Content & Objectives

Elaboration of the 4 skills required by the CEFR In conjunction with a wide variety of teaching aids. Work on grammar pronunciation and familiarization or deepening of points relating to French life During the first lesson the professor will invite students to download our **Grammar Guide** from the digital platform of our monthly magazine « **Le Français et Vous** ».

Methodology

The professor is present during the entire session. It is she/he who will direct the session according to the **methodological framework** established by the pedagogical direction of the CIA. Depending on the level of the professor's group, she/he will organize the sessions to **work on skills related to the objectives set**.

Each day at the start of the session, the course objectives are presented by the professor. At the end of each session, the professor will provide feedback and students will also be able to share observations. A link to the next session is then presented and homework may be distributed to students.

The courses focus is on oral communication. Our courses favor practical communication, both written and oral, as recommended by the CEFR and the DELF. The active learning pedagogy that has made the reputation of the CIA teaching methods is widely used.

BEFORE THE COURSE BEGINS

Level Evaluation Test Preparation for E learning



1. For reservations made **over 3 weeks prior to the course start date**

Students will receive the week before the course begins our "**online evaluation test**" as well as a small **questionnaire** in order to better identify their needs and expectations. The student must send them at the latest 5 working days before the start of the course.

2. For reservations made **under 3 weeks before the course start date**

Confirmation of the students reservation into our online courses will depend on the results of their level assesment test.

Along with the **Test** and the **Questionnaire** the student receives a "Guide" which explains which explains how the sessions are organised and how the zoom software works.

Once the level of the student has been determined, the educational director places the student in the appropriate group under the guidance of a professor. This structure is the most appropriate educational approach of allocation of students into a program based on the profile of their group as well as the duration of learning.
